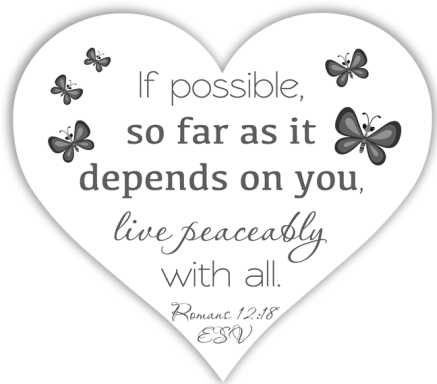
New Here?
